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Course Schedule

We will meet Tuesdays and Fridays from 12:15 p.m. – 1:40 p.m.

Class only meets twice a week; however, during that time we will cover five days of lessons. Tuesday will usually cover three days of lessons, while Friday will cover two days of lessons. Assignments will always be required to be returned to the teacher the following class once it has been assigned. Extra credit may be turned in at any time before the last day of on-campus classes for the semester.

Class Rules

As a CVA student, you are required to adhere to all of the policies in your student handbook. If you have any questions regarding a specific policy, please ask for clarity.

Assignment Policy & Google Classroom

This class utilizes Google Classroom; however, students are expected to turn in assignments on paper at the start of each class. If a student does not turn in his/her assignment when it is due, then they will have until the end of the day to turn in that assignment in Google Classroom under the correct topic/assignment. If they fail to turn it in appropriately online (which includes the assignment being easily viewable/legible), then their grade will go down by 5% for each class day it is late. For example, if an assignment is due on Tuesday and the student turns it in either online on Wednesday or Thursday, or in person on Friday, then it can earn no more than 95% (it may earn less based on content, please see the Assignment Rubric in Google Classroom). If the student turns it in the following Tuesday, it will earn no more than 90%, the following Friday, no more than 85%. After 3 class days late, which is a week and a half, the assignment will receive a 0 and will no longer be accepted.

Parents, you will receive an e-mail with a Missing Assignment Notice attached each time your student does not turn in an assignment on time, and each subsequent class day it is late until 3 class days have passed as described above. Please help your student turn in their assignment promptly when you receive the first notice.

As with all things, there are exceptions to the rule in extreme circumstances. Parents may call and speak to me in that case and I may allow extra time to complete an assignment without lowering the students grade.

Illness & Quarantine

If a student is quarantined for 2 weeks due to illness or exposure then they may continue to attend class from home. Parents must contact CVA to let us know if a student needs to attend class virtually under these circumstances. If a student is unable to attend digitally due to severe illness then adjustments will be made to help the student upon full recovery. Otherwise, students will attend class via Google Meet or Zoom at the same time class usually meets on campus. All assignments will be turned in via Google Classroom, and are still expected to be turned in on time.
